**Lent in Our Parish – 2026:** Lent is now upon us and there are lots of things happening across both of our churches to help us pray, reflect and prepare for Easter. Throughout Lent there will be regular Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, Stations of the Cross in both churches, Holy Hours with Adoration and Confession, online scripture reflection on Mondays, the Evangelium course in Brigg, youth and teens gatherings, prayer ministry opportunities, and two special parish events:

- Lenten Reflection Morning (Barton – 21st March)
- Parish Lenten Retreat Afternoon (Brigg – 28th March)
